The average crude oil production during 2008-09 in Venezuela and Russia was 30,886 and 7,747 bopd (barrel oil per day) respectively. In Myanmar, the OVL has surrendered its participating interest, as the seismic and drilled well data of the project did not warrant entry into exploration period. The Projects in Brazil and Columbia are currently under exploration phase.
