Development of medium cities

1465. SHRI T.T.V. DHINAKARAN: Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is proposed to develop selected medium cities on the lines of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM) Scheme;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SAUGATA RAY): (a) and (b) No, Sir. However, hundred days agenda of the Ministry refers to concerted effort to include cities with population of 5 lakh and above under the Mission.

(c) The cities which are presently not covered under the Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM) have been covered under the other scheme of the Ministry, namely, Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for Small and Medium Towns (UIDSSMT) which aims at improvement in urban infrastructure in small and medium towns and cities in a planned manner.
