

3D Video database of New Delhi

2828. SHRI RAJEEV SHUKLA: Will the Minister of SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have a programme to create a 3D video surveillance database of New Delhi;

(b) if so, the details of the programme and estimated date of its completion;

(c) the benefits of the programme;

(d) whether such programme will be implemented in other cities in the country; and

(e) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (SHRI KAPIL SIBAL): (a) and (b) No, Sir. However, under Department of Science and Technology (DST), a research project was initiated in collaboration with the Russian Academy of Sciences for creating a 3-D Global Information System (GIS) database/video surveillance for City Zone-I in Delhi on pilot basis to demonstrate the technology. The Technology is still at the stage of testing and validation. Other parts of the Delhi are not being covered by DST.

(c) The 3D GIS Database/surveillance system has a number of applications like change detection, urban planning and disaster management etc.

(d) and (e) Being a pilot project, no such programme is contemplated for any other major city at this stage.
