Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether survey of orphans in the country is carried out;
- (b) if so, the statistics during the last three years, State-wise;
- (c) the number of Government and Non-Governmental Organisations for their care, State-wise;
- (d) whether Non-Governmental Organisations are assisted; and
- (e) if so, the basis thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI KRISHNA TIRATH): (a) and (b) No survey of orphans has been carried out by the Ministry of Women and Child Development.

(c) to (e) Ministry of Women and Child Development is providing financial assistance to State Government/Union Territory Administrations under the Scheme – 'A Programme for Juvenile Justice' for establishment and maintenance of homes for children in need of care and protection as well as children in conflict with law. State-wise number of such homes assisted during 2008-09 is given in the Statement (*See below*). The State Government may set up & run the homes either by itself or in association with the voluntary organizations. In addition, the Ministry is also implementing the 'Scheme of Assistance to Homes for Children (Shishu Greha) to Promote In-country Adoption' under which financial assistance is provided to NGOs/State Governments and Union Territory Administrations for running the Shishu Grehas which take care of orphan/abandoned children upto 6 years of age with a view to place them in adoption. State-wise number of such Shishu Grehas being assisted are given in the Statement (*See below*). The financial assistance under the above said schemes are provided as per the norms of the schemes.
