

(b) whether she will take firm steps to clear these people from the platform area and see that all station platforms remain clean and safe in Orissa?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI E. AHAMMED): (a) and (b) Regular drives are conducted by Railway Protection Force (RPF) in trains & Railway premises to keep the Station free from undesirable elements/ criminal elements and the offenders are being prosecuted under the provisions of the Railways Act. During the year 2009 (upto October) 7,877 persons have been arrested under the various section of the Railways Act and realized fine Rs. 7,27,343/- . All efforts are made to keep station area clean.

These recommendations *inter alia* relate to setting up of multi-functional complexes across Indian Railways by bringing in appropriate Private Equity, development of world class stations over Indian Railways through Public-Private Partnership (PPP) mode, and setting up of locomotive and rail coach factories through Joint Venture/ Private Equity models. Recommendations of the Expert Committee have been accepted and action for the implementation of the same has been initiated.
