THE MINISTER OF TOURISM AND CULTURE (SHRI ANANTH KUMAR): (a) No, Sir.

(b) and (c) Question does not arise.

Promotional Policy in ASI

(a) whether it is a fact that the posts of Additinal Director General and Director General of Archaeological Survey of India are held by IAS Officers;

(b) whether it also a fact that the present promotional policy renders professional archaeologists and scientists of ASI ineligible to the above two posts; and

(c) if so, how Government propose to rectify the anomaly?

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM AND CULTURE (SHRI ANANTH KUMAR): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) No, Sir. As per the existing Recruitment Rules notified in 1982 none of the officers in the ASI have completed the requisite number of years in the feeder grade to be eligible for promotion to the posts of Director General and Additional Director General (ASI)

(c) Amendments to the existing Recruitment Rules have been taken up for improving the promotion prospects of the officers of the ASI.
