Scheme for girl education

*62. SHRI TARIQ ANWAR: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have prepared any special scheme/project for girl education in the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the names of the districts which are covered under this scheme, especially in Bihar and Maharashtra?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) to (c) At the elementary stage of education, the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA), the National Programme for Education of Girls at Elementary Level (NPEGEL) and the Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya (KGBV) programmes are the principal programmes to address girls education. The SSA covers all districts of the country while the NPEGEL and KGBV programmes are focused on Educationally Backward Blocks (EBBs) in the country. All eligible EBBs in Bihar and Maharashtra have been covered under the NPEGEL programme and 128 EBBs in Bihar and 27 in Maharashtra, under the KGBV scheme.

At the higher secondary level, the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has a scholarship scheme for the meritorious single girl child studying in schools affiliated to it.
