THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE (SHRr P. R. DAS. MUNSHI): (a) and (b) During the visit of the Bahrain Minister of Development and Industry to India in February, 1988, agreed minutes were signed between the Minister of Industry and the Bahraini Minister which inter-alia expressed the interest of the two countries to expand the areas of cooperation through joint'ventures in fields like fertilizers and tyres.

- (c) Kudremukh Iron Ore Company Limited (KIOCL) has signed a long term agreement with Arab Iron-& Steel Com pany Limited (AISCO), Bahrain for ex port of iron ore concentrate. . However; the AISCO plant has not been operating since September, 86 and the exports en visaged have, therefore, not materialised.
- (d) As per the indications given ear lier by AISCO, Bahrain they were to import upto 1.5 million tonnes of con centrate from KIOCL in 1988.
- (e) The quantity of iron ore exported by India to Bahrain during 1986-87 has been 0.59 lakh tonnes. No exports have taken place during 1987-88.
