

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI RAFIQUE ALAM): (a) to (c) Area off Goa Coast is a part of Kerala-Konkan basin. Three wells, namely, Cochin-I, Kasarged-I and Karwar-I, which were drilled in this basin during 1978-80, proved dry. Drilling of another well namely Cochfih High-I has since been completed and the well is under testing.

The basin is under exploration and the quantum of likely crude production will be known only after successful exploratory results.

(d) Presently there is no such plan.
