Utilisation/disposal of arms and am-munition seized from terrorists

1591. SHRI MOHINDER SINGH; LATHER; Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have taken any decision with regard to the utilisation/disposal of the arms' and ammunition seized from the terrorists or unearthed by the police*;

(b) if so, what are the details thereof stating the manner of their disposal/utilisation; and

(c) whether there is any proposal to sell/auction such arms to the people, particularly of the border and the terrorist affected areas?;

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS AND THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI P. CHIDAM BARAM): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. According to the instructions issued to the State Governments/UTs from time to time, the State Police authorities are allowed to retain/use weapons of prohibited bore with approval of the State Government/U.T. Administration concerned. A report regarding weapons of service pattern/prohibited bore and weapons

of civil non-prohibited bore not required by the State *Police Forces* is required to be sent to the Army Headquarters for their instructions for disposal of such weapons.

(c) There is no proposal to sell/ auction the Seized/confiscated arms to the people of border and terrorist affected areas.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AFFAIRS IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI EDUARDO FALEIRO): (a) No, Sir.

Decline in the export of F.C.U. Tobacco

1594. DR. YELAMANCHILI SIVAJI: Will the Minister of COMMERCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether there has been a decline in the export of F.C.U. tobacco; and

(b) if so, what are the reasons therefor and what remedial measures have been taken by Government in the matter?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE (SHRI P. R. DAS MUNSHI): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The reasons for decline in the export of tobacco are the worldwide slowing down of demand and, particularly, reduces offtake by USSR of our tobacco. The steps being taken to boost the export of tobacco are:-

— Exports of tobacco to China have been permitted on DA- terms (Documents against Acceptance) with the time stipulation being 30 days within which collection would be made after discharge of cargo at the port of destination.

—Exports of tobacco to Egypt have been permitted with payment terms involving 50 per cent against presentation of documents on shipment and balance 50 per cent on arrival* of goods after inspection in Egypt.

—Exports to Egypt and Algeria have been permitted by extension of one year credit.
