

Improper housing of children in Navodaya School Hostel at Horseley Hills in Andhra Pradesh

1808. DR. NARREDDY THULASI REDDY: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that ten children are sharing a single room in Navodaya School hostel situated at Horseley Hills in Andhra Pradesh; and

(b) if so, what are the reasons therefor and the steps proposed to be taken to ease the situation?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF EDUCATION AND CULTURE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI L. P. SHAHI): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. In view of the fact that the Navodaya Vidyalaya at Horseley Hills is presently functioning in a temporary building provided by the State Government of Andhra Pradesh, there is some shortage of accommodation. It is proposed to ease the situation (a) by making more accommodation available on the site with the consent of State Government of Andhra Pradesh and (b) by constructing our own buildings in due course.

Allocation of funds to Guntur Macherla line for conversion from MG to BG

1809. DR. YALAMANCHILI SIVAJI: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state what are the reasons for not spending the allotted amount on gauge conversion of Guntur to Macherla line of South Central Railway during 1986-87?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MAHABIR PRASAD): P. Way materials arranged for the work were transferred to other priority works in Andhra Pradesh, which were nearing completion. This resulted in the expenditure being less than the original allotment in 1986-87.
