Group Life Insurance Scheme for IRDP beneficiaries

*295. SHRI BASUDEB MOHAPA-TRA: Will the Minister of AGRICUL-TURE be pleased to state.-

(a) whether it is a fact that a Group Life Insurance Scheme 'for the bene ficiaries of the Integrated Rural Development Programme has been introduced through out the country from lst April, 1988;

(b) if so, what are the details thereof;

(c) the number: of beneficiaries expected to toe covered under the scheme every year; and*

(d) the amount proposed to toe assured to the beneficiaries under the scheme?

THE MINTSTER OF STATE IN DEPARTMENT OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI JANAR-DHAN POOJARI): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The Group Insurance Scheme will apply to all IRDP beneficiaries between the age of 18 to 60 years who are assisted after 1-4-88. The insurance cover is for a period of 3 years and the amount payable on the death of beneficiary is Rs. 3000. In the event of death by accident, the family of the Beneficiary will receive Rs. 6000. The. total amount of premium payable to Life Insurance Corporation of India to cover all beneficiaries (upto 4 million per year) during 1988-89 is Rs. 15.00 crores and during 1989-90, it will be Rs.. 2000 crores. The cost of premium will be shared equally by the Government of India and the State Governments. No oart of premium is payable by the beneficiary.

(C) It is proposed to cover around 3 to 4 million IRDP beneficiaries every year.

(d)The sum assured will be Rs. 3000 with double benefit (Rs. 6000) in the case of accidental death.

Welfare of Blind Persons

*296. SHRI CHATURANAN -MISH-RA; Will the Minister of WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) the number of blind persons covered by the programmes for their welfare and rehabilitation starred by Govt., either directly or through voluntary organisations; and

(b) whether Government are. satisfied' ;with the situation in this regard; if not, what corrective/remedial steps are proposed to be taken?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF WELFARE (DR. RAJENDRA KUMARI BAJPAI); (a) The number of blind persons who benefitted directly from welfare and rehabilitation programmes organised with assistance of Government of India during 1986-87 was estimated at 8085. Figures regarding persons who benefitted through programmes of State Govts, or of nongrantee voluntary organisations are not available.

(b) Considering the large number of blind people iri India there is need for expanding the programmes for their welfare and rehabilitation. With the available resources- concerted effort shall continue to be made to improve the quality and quantity of these programmes. However, there is also much scope for more community effort through non-governmental organisations.

Cultivation of 'VL, Dhan 165' in rainfed areas

*298. SHRIMATI VEENA VERMA: SHRI KAPIL VERMA:

Will the Mnister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether 'VL Dhan 163' evolved hy the Vivekanand Parvatiya Krishi

Atiusandhan Shala Almora was released for cultivation in the rainfed areas of mid-hills of Uttar Pradesh;

(b) if so, what were the results achieved and what has been the rice yield in tonnes per hactare; and

(c) by when this variety of Dhan is likely to be tried in other rainfed areas of the country especially in the North-Eastern States?

THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI BHAJAN LAL)f (a) Yes, Sir. VL-Dhan-163 has been released for rainfed uplands of U.P. hills and notified vide SO 471(E) dated 5-5-88 by Government of India.

(b) In the multilocation yield trials and coordinated experiments conducted in U.P., VL-Dhan 163 gave an average yield of 24-25 q/ha as against 18-21 q/ha, respectively recorded in the case of check variety 'Bala'. Data on performance of VL-Dhan 163 in U.P. in given iri the Statement (See below).

(c) Seeds are being multiplied for undertaking testing of this variety in rainfed upland areas of North Eastern Hill Region.
