A lawyer and a journalist, Shri Dave was the Editor of 'Ianata', a weekly organ of the Praja Socialist Party. He played a major role in prompting the activities of the Indian National Theatre. He had made a deep study of Marxism as also of Buddhism and was a Sanskrit scholar.

He represented the State of Gujarat in the Rajya Sabha from April 1958 to April 1964,

In the passing away of Shrimati Fathema Ismail, the country has lost a noted social worker and freedom fighter. Born in February, 1903 in Bombay, Shrimati Ismail had her education at the Universities of Bombay, Cambridge and Vienna.

A dedicated social worker, Shrimati Ismail set up a society for the education of disabled and crippled children. She also took active part in the freedom struggle and the "Quit India" movement.

Shrimati Ismail's dedication to social work earned for her national recognition when she was awarded "Padma Shree" in 1958. The State Government of Maharashtra conferred on her the title "Dalit Mitra". She was nominated to this House in 1978.

We deeply mourn the pasing away of Dr. K. Mathew Kurian, Shri Satyendra Prosad Ray, Shri Ramchandra Bhardwaj, Shri Rohit Manushankar Dave and Shrimati Fathema Ismail.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DLPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND COOPERATION IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI YOGFNDRA MAKWANA): (a) to (c) The Government of Uttar Pradesh in their memorandum for seeking central assistance had sought R<sub>5</sub>, 529.84 crores under Employment Generation Scheme, including Rs. 67.66 crores for Rural Engineering Services, A ceiling of expenditure of Rs. 100.62 crores has been apaporved to the State Government under this head.
