During the first, two years and the third year of the 7th Plan so far, the Ministry has sanctioned an amount of Rs. 129. 40 lakhs for various tourism projects in the State. An amount of Rs. 94. 28 lakhs has been released to the State Government which is inclusive of the amount released on account of projects sanctioned in the earlier years. Financial assistance has been sanctioned /released for the following projects: —
