Visit of US team for transfer to technology for the LCA

2054. SHRIMATI KRISHNA KAUL: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a US team recently visited India to work out details for the transfer of technology, to help Indra to make its own light combat aircraft (LCA); and
- (b) if so, what are the details of the decision taken?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENCE PRO-DUCTION AND SUPPLIES IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI SHIVRAJ PATIL): (a) Yes Sir. delegation from the US Govt. visited India during November 9-14, 1987. It was composed of scientists/engineers from the laboratories of the US Air Force and officers who will be manning 'single window' for LCA-related export clearance. The single window is the US Air Force.

(b) The discussions focussed on the methods of implementing laboratoryto-laboratory cooperation for acquisition and absorption of advanced aeronautics technologies like digital flight control, avionics systems integration simulation, and composite materials. Prospects of considering USA as a source for components, systems which are not yet produced indigenously were also considered. The procurement or progressive manufacture of such items will be governed by technoeconomic considerations consistent with our national interest.

In addition, Bharat Electronics Ltd., have also applied for a letter of intent because the location proposed is within the standard urban area limit of Bangalore and thus not covered under the delicensing provisions. A decision on their application is yet to be taken.

(d) The current price of the tubes of M/s. Uptron Colour Picture Tubes Ltd. is Rs. 1750/- and that of M/s. Punjab Display Devices Ltd. (now M/s. JCT Electronics Ltd.) is Rs. 1745/-Since, the first phase of production based on yamming started only in 1987, the question of providing the price of fnese tubes on 1st January,

1986 and 1st January, 1987 does not arise.

(e) Production of Colour TV Picture Tubes has not yet started. However, fixing and adjusting the yoke (called yamming) on to the Colour Picture Tubes has started in two units and upto 31st October, 1987 65529 tubes were yammed locally. It is estimated that approximately 2.75 million Colour Picture Tubes have been imported during 1st January, 1985 to 31st October, 1987 with a total foreign exchange spending of approximately Rs. 220/crores.
