Home Ministry's Instruction to Central
Government Employees to put up notes
and Drafts in Hindi

SHRI V. GOPALSAMY (Tamil Nadu):
Mr. Vice-Chairman, Sir, the Home Ministry has given instructions to the employees in all the States belong to 'A' and 'B' categories to use Hindi in their drafts and correspondence from April 1. Sir, the Home Ministry has become the fountain-head of Hindi jingoism and chauvinism. This was created during the days of emergency. The Home Minister, Mr. Buta Singh, stated recently that all the Government employees in States 'A' & 'B' category would be asked to use Hindi in their drafts and correspondence from April 1. Since the days of the Constituent Assembly the Hindi zealots are trying through all over and covert means to thrust and impose Hindi on Non-Hindi speaking people.

The Government cannot take shelter under the argument that only 'A' and 'B' category States have been asked to implement Hindi alone. When the correspondence emanates from A and B category States towards the other category States i.e. the non-Hindi speaking States, that will create unjustifiable hardships for those States as the Hindi correspondence is nothing but sheer imposition on them. The Home Minister specifically stated that Andaman and Nicobar Islands will

be covered under the new directive and Hindi will be fully implemented. Out of three lakh population in Andaman and Nicobar Islands, only a negligible number of two to three thousand Hindi-speaking people are there from the Hindi belt whereas the majority of the population are Tamils first and then Bengalis, Malayans and Telugus. The Administration in the Islands has already launched all draconian measures to make the island a Hindi State. Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru gave the assurance to allay the fears of the non-Hindi speaking people that Hindi will never be imposed on them. This was reiterated by Madam Gandhi and other Prime Ministers. What happened to those assurances? Have they been thrown to the wind? Are they buried fathom deep? English is the window for world knowledge, India is a multi-lingual, multi-cultural and multi-national State. Hindi belt areas alone is not India. If this Government plays the role of Hindi bulldozers, then I warn you that the unity and integrity of India will be definitely shattered to pieces. The biggest question before us is: "Do we want Hindi India or United India?" There are members from both the sides, the opposition and the Treasury Benches, who may not agree with me. But it is my duty to express my point of view. The biggest question before us is "Do we want Hindi India or United India?" This question will determine the future destiny of the unity of India. The non-Hindi speaking people cannot live like second-rate citizens, like a subject race. Tamils in Tamil Nadu as well as in Andaman and Nicobar Islands will fight Hindi chauvinism inch by inch.

I urge upon the Government not to pursue this dictatorial attitude and withdraw the instruction given to the Government employees to use Hindi drafts and to permit them to use English also according to their option. Thank you.

DR. BAPU KALDATE: I have not exaggerated. I had said on the contrary that they could have closed the airport for some time. They cannot close it for...

SHRI A. G. KULKARNI: Please convey our concern to the Civil Aviation Ministry for their entire lopsided attitude in closing down the entire airport. He is quite right. There are many tourists and many foreigners also. The Civil Aviation Ministry is lax in good manners and behaviour with the travelling public and tourists. I have got some experience. They say of facilitation centres where there are ladies and air hostesses. They are totally ignorant. If we tell them that we are Members of Parliament, then they will retort, "Does it mean that you are Member of Parliament and we should serve you? We serve the public." OK. Please serve the public. But do not read English magazines, Star Dust and those things before them. So, Sir, the Civil Aviation Ministry is to be castigated in this affair. Vajpayeeji, Star Dust is a magazine for females, not for you.

SHRI ATAL BIHARI VAJPAYEE (Madhya Pradesh): These days they read 'Society', not 'Star Dust'.

THE VICE-CHAIRMAN (SHRI JAGESH DESAI): The Parliamentary Affairs Minister to make a statement.
