The requisite information is given below.-

Scheme for providing Self-Employment to the Educated Unemployed Youth (SEEUY) was initially launched, a provision was made to give a composite loan upto Rs. 25,000/- for setting up industrial, service and business ventures. From the year 1986-87, while the ceiling on loans for industrial ventures has been raised to Rs. 35,000/-, for service ventures it has been kept unaltered at Rs. 25,000/- and for business ventures reduced to Rs 15,000/- . No further change in the loan amount for different routes has been made since then. Separate allocation of funds is not made for each State and physical targets in terms of beneficiaries are centrally allotted to different States. For the year 1987-88, an *ad hoc* target of 14,800 has been laid down for Bihar.
