Houses for the Rural Landless Labour Scheme in M.P.

Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to refer to

answer to Unstarred Question 696 and 697 given in Rajya Sabha on the 13th November, 1987 and state:

(a) whether any special campaign was launched to accelerate work on the Houses for the Rural Landless Labour Scheme during the Interna-

tional year of Shelter for Homeless in 1987; and

(b) what is the estimated number of rural homeless families in Madhya Pradesh and by when they are likely to be provided with houses?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI DALBIR SINGH):

(a) Yes, Sir. The State Governments/UT Administrations constituted committees and also designated focal points to accelerate the formulation, implementation and monitoring of various shelter programmes. Further, the scheme of Allotment of House-sites and construction assistance which forms part of Point No. 14 of the 20-Point Programme, 1986 was one of the schemes designated as the National Demonstration Projects under IYSH. The accelerated pace of implementation of the scheme is illustrated by the fact that during the year 1987, 8.94 lakh families were allotted house-sites and construction assistance was provided to 4.16 lakh families in the rural areas by various State Govts/UT Admns.

(b) According to 1981 census, there was 2.79 lakh rural homeless population in M.P. However, under the scheme of the House-sites and Construction Assistance, since Sixth Five Year Plan, and upto 31st December, 1987, 2.77 lakh families were allotted house-sites and construction assistance was given to 2.62 lakh families in the rural areas of M.P.

Welfare schemes for disabled children in M.P.

Will the Minister of WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) what are the details of the schemes introduced for the welfare of disabled children in the State of Madhya Pradesh during the last three years;

(b) the amount spent during this period for the purpose; and

(c) what is the estimated number of disabled children in the State and whether any initiative has been taken to make them useful citizens of the nation?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF WELFARE (SHRI-MATI SUMATI ORAON): (a) and (b) Schemes taken up by Government of India for the welfare of the disabled children are applicable in all States including Madhya Pradesh.

A statement in respect of such schemes is placed on the Table of the House. (See below).

(c) In the year 1981, the National Sample Survey Organisation conducted a sample survey of disabled persons covering only physical disabilities.

According to this survey the percentage of physically disabled children (0 — 14 years) is approximately 3%.

Regarding the mentally retarded children no reliable statistics are available.

Statement

(i) The Scheme of Assistance to Organisation for Disabled persons:-

Grant-in-aid is given to Vol. Organisations who are engaged in providing education, training and rehabilitation facilities to Disabled persons. The applications of such Organisations are received through the State Govt. of Madhya Pradesh for grant-in-aid. The details of grants-in-aid released during 1984-85, 1985-86 and 1986-87 to Organisations in the State of Madhya Pradesh is as under:—
