Development of major ports

Will the Minister of SURFACE TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Government have received *offers* from American President Lines and some foreign shipping companies to develop Bombay, Madras and other major ports of the country;

(b) if so, the details of such proposal;

(c) the reaction of Government to -uch proposal;

(d) whether Government propose lo in vite Indian businessmen also for submit ting similar proposals; and

(e) the terms and conditions set forth by these companies?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI RAJESH PILOT): (a) to (e) American President Lines had offered assistance for developing and operating a modern container terminal at Bombay Port. They had also shown interest in develop; container terminal at Madras, B formal proposal for Madras has been ved.

The propositi for Bombay envis Joint Venture with some Indian Companies to develop and operate a Container Terminal at Ballard Pier in Bombay Port Govt, are not in favour of the above proposals. There is no proposal before Government for inviting Indian businessmen to submit similar proposals for the above ports.

Facilities for passengers at railway stations in West Bengal

(b) the amount spent for the modernisation of railway stations in West Bengal during the last three years, year-wise; and

(c) the amount to be allotted for this purpose during 1988-89?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS fSHRI MAHABTR PRASAD): (a) Amenities at the stations are provided as per the norms laid down on the basis of the volume of traffic dealt with at the station. Deficiencies, if any, are made up in a phased manner depending upon the availability of funds.
