They had also shown interest in develop; container terminal at Madras, B formal proposal for Madras has been ved.

The propositi for Bombay envis Joint Venture with some Indian Companies to develop and operate a Container Terminal at Ballard Pier in Bombay Port Govt, are not in favour of the above proposals. There is no proposal before Government for inviting Indian businessmen to submit similar proposals for the above ports.
