#### **Impact of I AB to Land Programme**

2570. SHRI SHANTI TYAGI; Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pieased to state;

(a) what is the total number of fami lies and the number of villages covered under the Lab to Land Programme till the end of the year 1987;

(b) whether any study ha<sub>s</sub> been con ducted by Government evaluating the im pact of this programme on the families covered so; and

(c) if so, what are the findings thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH AND EDUCATION IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI HARIKRISHNA SHASTRI); (a) Initiated in 1979, the Lab to Land Programme has covered 2,33,502 farm families by the end of the year 1987. These families were adopted through 446 Lab to> Land centres. Each centre covered 5 to 50 villages depending upon number of farm families adopted.

tb) Yes, Sir. An Evaluation Committee was set up during the year 1984 to evaluate the Lab to Land Programmes.

(c) The Committee made several re-commendations regarding approach and methodology, supervision and monitoring, use of critical inputs and the technologies used under the Lab to Land Programme. The Commtttee found the Lab to Land Programme very useful for the small, marginal farmers and landless agricultural labourers.

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR (SHRI JAGDISH TYTLER); (a) and (b) The appropriate government takes into consideration all relevant factors and follows suitable criteria while fixing the minimum wages in respect of scheduled employments. The Labour Ministers' Conference at its 36th session held on 20th
