

**Direct Flight between Srinagar and Calcutta**

2880. DR. R. K. PODDAR: Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is any proposal to operate direct flight between Srinagar and Calcutta; and

(b) if so, by when?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE AND THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI MOTI LAL VORA): (a) No, Sir.

(b) Does not arise.

**Flyover at Liluah Railway Station in West Bengal**

2881. SHRI MOSTAFA BIN QUASEM: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is any proposal under Government's consideration to construct flyover near the level crossing at Liluah Railway Station in Howrah district of West Bengal;

(b) if so, whether any survey has been made in this regard; and

(c) by when the work is likely to be started at this busiest level crossing?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MADHAVRAO SCINDIA): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir.

(c) The work on bridge proper will be executed by the Railway and on approaches by the State Government, after the detailed plans and estimates, and programme for execution of work are finalised jointly with the State Government.

**Conversion of Ahmedpur-Katwa Rail Line into Broad Gauge**

**National Goitre Programme**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (KUMARI SAROJ KHAPARDE): (a) and (b) Iodisation of entire edible salt in a phased manner to be completed by 1992 is the main objective of the National Goitre Control Programme. During 1987-88, a quantity of 13.82 lakh tonnes of iodised salt has been produced against the production of 7.56 lakh tonnes of iodised salt during 1986-87.
