

### Glorification of Sati

239. SHRI K. MOHANAN: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state what action has so far been taken to stop glorification of Sati so far?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS AND WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI MARGARET ALVA): Section 5 of the Commission of Sati (Prevention) Act, 1987 prohibits glorification of "Sati". The glorification of "Sati" shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than one year but which may extend to seven years and with fine which shall not be less than five thousand rupees but which may extend to thirty thousand rupees. The Act is required to be implemented by the State Government and the Union Territory Administrations concerned.
