239 SHRI K. MOHANAN: Will the Ministe'r of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state what action has so far been taken to stop glorification of Sati so far?

THE MINISTER OF STATE DEPARTMENTS OF YOUTH THE AFFAIRS AND SPORTS AND WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOP-MINISTRY OF MENT IN THE HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOP-(SHRIMATI MARGARET MENT ALVA): Section 5 of the Commission of Sati (Prevention) Act, 1987 prohibits glorification of "Sati'. "Sati" shall glorification of punishable with imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than one year but which may extend to seven years and with fine which shall not be less than five thousand rupees but which may extend to thirty thousand rupees. The Act is required to be implemented by the State Government and the Union Territory Administrations concerned.
