Appointment of trade union leaders on the Boards of Directors

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR (SHRI JAGDISH TYTLER): (a) The names of seven public enterprises referred to in Unstarred Question No. 3382-B were BHEL, EGIN Mills, National News-Print and Paper Mills Ltd., NTC (Gujarat), NTC (South Maharashtra), NTC (West Bengal, Assam, Bihar and Orissa) and Rashtriya Chemicals and Fertilizers Ltd.
