

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI BRAHM DUTT): (a) Construction of the first section of the pipeline from Hazira to Bijaipur (640 km) has been completed and is presently under commissioning. Work on the second sector from Bijaipur to Aonla is in progress;

(b) The total cost of the project is at present expected to be about Rs. 1700 crores. The project is expected to be completed by July, 1989 as originally scheduled.

(c) Supply of gas from the HBJ pipeline has not commenced.

Planning Commission's sanction of additional funds for power projects

(c) whether the places have been located for setting up new power projects with additional funds; and

(d) if so, what are the State-wise details in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF POWER IN THE MINISTRY OF ENERGY (SHRIMATI SUSHILAROHATGI): (a) An addition-

al outlay of about Rs. 11,200 crores during the Seventh Plan has been approved for the Power Sector.

(b) 9760 MW.

## Tariff disputes among the states

1014. SHRI F. M. \* KHAN: Will the Minister of ENERGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are aware that power tariff disputes among the States have been pending for long; if so, since when;

(b) whether these disputes have resulted in the fall of power generation in some states;

(c) which are those States and whether the States with surplus power are demanding high tariff;

(d) whether Government have taken any steps or initiative to solve these disputes; and

(e) if so, what are the reasons for delay in resolving the inter-State disputes in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF POWER IN THE MINISTRY OF ENERGY (SHRIMATI SUSHILA ROHATGI): (a) to (e) Generation and supply of power by States is regulated according to the powers conferred on them by the Electricity (Supply) Act, 1948. They exchange power on mutually agreed terms. According to information available, power generation in 1986-87 was 187568 MU as compared to 170037 MU in 1985-86.

## Power plant in Assam

1015. SHRIMATI BIJOYA CHAKRAVARTY: Will the Minister of ENERGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is any proposal under the consideration of the Government for setting up a new power plant in Assam in order to improve the power position in that State; and

(b) if so, what are the details in the regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF POWER IN THE MINISTRY OF ENERGY (SHRIMATI SUSHILA ROHATGI): (a) and (b) A Gas-based Power Project (270 MW) at an estimated cost of Rs. 566.22 crores, is to be set up at Kathalguri. In addition the following two hydro-electric schemes of Assam are under techno-economic appraisal in the Central Electricity Authority:—
