

Railway station in Andhra Pradesh

2835. SHRI TALARI MANOHAR: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) what is the number of railway stations in Andhra Pradesh selected for upgradation during the current plan, districtwise list and

(b) the number of new railway stations to be opened in Andhra Pradesh during the current plan?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MADHAVRAO SCINDIA): (a) The following four stations have been selected to be developed as model stations in Andhra Pradesh in the districts indicated against each:—

Name of Model	Name Of District
1. Hyderabad	Hyderabad
2. Vijayawada	Krishna
3. Tirupathi	Chittoor
4. Waltair	Vizag south

(b) During Seventh Plan, on New lines, 6 stations have been opened and another six stations are planned to be opened.

Difficulties in getting admission in undergraduate courses of Delhi University

2836. SHRIMATI KRISHNA KAUL: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the number of students who could not secure admission to undergraduate courses of Delhi University in the current academic session;

(b) the reasons for which they could not be admitted in colleges; and

(c) the steps Government are taking to secure admission for them?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF EDUCATION AND CULTURE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI KRISHNA SAHI): (a) According to Delhi University, 46,267 students had obtained 40 per cent marks and above in the Senior Secondary School Examination in Delhi this year and are eligible for admission to various undergraduate courses in Delhi University and its colleges during the current academic session. The seats available in the regular courses, the correspondence courses, the Non-Collegiate Women's Education Board and the External Candidate's Cell will be adequate to accommodate all the eligible candidates.

(b) and (c) Do not arise.

Boriui Bridge at Pondain GOA

2837. SHRI JOHN F- FERNANDES: Will the Minister of SURFACE TRANSPORT be pleased to state

(a) whether Government have any plan for repairing and rehabilitating the Old Borim Bridge at Ponda in Goa by replacing the Baily Bridge Span" and restoring it to its original form; and

(b) whether Government contemplate to build a new bridge in the near future along river Zuari, parallel to the existing bridge in view of the collapse of Man-dovi Bridge?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI RAJESH PILOT): (a)

The Government of India are responsible for the development and maintenance of roads declared as National Highways. The repairs and rehabilitation of the bridge in question is the concern of the Government of Goa as it falls on a State road.

(b) There is no plan for construction of another bridge over river Zuari on National Highway.
