Recommendations of the High Power Committee on problems of ex-servicemen

Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

(a) what is the number of recommendations of the High Power Committee on problems of Ex-servicemen, the number of those recommendations which have been accepted, those which have been partly accepted and the number of those recommendations which are under consideration by Government; and

(b) what are the reasons for delay in accepting all the recommendations?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENCE PRODUCTION AND SUPPLIES IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI SHIVRAJ PATIL): (a) The High Level Committee on Problems of Ex-servicemen (HLC) made 68 recommendations. Forty-Nine of its recommendations have been accepted and five have been partly accepted. Three recommendations are likely to be accepted or are of consequential nature. Seven recommendations of the HLC have not been accepted out of 4 are to be taken care of through existing schemes/organisations. There are only 4 recommendations on which decisions have not been taken so far.

(b) There has been delay in taking decisions on a few recommendations because of need for examination of wider issues involved study of feasibility including repercussions on ex-

isting cadres of employees and financial implications.

(b) if so, by when it is likely to be opened; and

(c) what are the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI AJIT PANJA): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The proposed radio station at Berhampore is expected to be ready during 1989. As regards the proposed radio station at Asansol, the site is yet to be taken over. Depending on early handing over of the site, the proposed radio station at Asansol is likely to be ready by March, 1990.

(c) Berhampore—Local Radio Station with 2x3 KW FM Transmitter, Multi purpose Studios, Receiving Facilities and staff quarters.

Asansol—Local Radio Station with 2x3 KW FM Transmitter Multi purpose Studios, Receiving Facilities and staff quarters.

Regional language programmes from Doordarshan

(c) The present contents of the morning service being telecast from Delhi, cater to the entire country. As such starting the programme in regional languages from Doordarshan Kendras is not considered necessary.

(c) The morning transmission telecast from Delhi is relayed by all Doordarshan Kendras including Calcutta. As such, starting the programme in regional language from Calcutta is not considered necessary.
