(c) House owners are eligible for government accommodation hence separate statistics are not being maintained.

(d) and (e) After detailed consideration Government have decided that house owning officers should be eligible for allotment of general pool residential accommodation and hence it is not proposed to withdraw government residential accommodation from house owning officials.
