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MINISTRY OF ENERGY (SHRIMATI SUSHILA ROHATGI): (a) and (b) The National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC) exceeded its target for power generation in 1986-87. The organisation_s which did not achieve the target during 1986-87 along with details are indicated in the enclosed Statement. (See below).

The main reasons for the short-fall in thermal generation include forced outage of thermal units, long time taken in maintenance and major repairs equipment deficiencies etc. The shortfall in hydro generation was mainly due to low reservoir levels.
