

### **Curtailing of the Activities of ITDC**

3571. SHRI SURAJ PRASAD: Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that a well-planned strategy is being worked out in the Ministry with the help of some senior officials of ITDC to curtail the activities of ITDC enshrined in its Memorandum of Articles and Association so as to help the private sector in the field of accommodation| catering and transport services; and

(b) if so, what are the facts of the case and what steps are being taken against such officials to save ITDC, a public sector enterprise, from the clutches of such bureaucrats?
