Promotion of tourism in Rajasthan

219. SHRI SANTOSH BAGRODIA: Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state the financial allocation made by the Central Government for the promotion of tourism in Rajasthan during the Seventh Five Year Plan Period, scheme-wise?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION AND TOURISM (SHRI JAGDISH TYTLER): The Ministry of Tourism does not allocate funds Statewise but schemewise. The Ministry gives financial assistance to States on the basis of proposals received from State Governments, subject to merits of the case, availability of funds and inter-se priorities. However, during the 7th Five Year Plan Period, the following projects have been sanctioned for Rajasthan so far:-
