Strategy for curbing growth of Black Money

547. SHRI PARVATHANENI UPENDRA: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether any specific strategy has been prepared for curbing the growth of black money; and

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI JANARDHAN POOJARI): (a) and (b) Government's fully committed to unearth black money and arrest its growth. One limb of Government's policy is eliciting voluntary compliance through liberalisation of Summary Assessment Scheme. The other limb is intensification of deter-

rent actions like intensive scrutiny, search and seizure, survey and prosecutions.

Preparation of Super Conductors from Metal Alloys

548. SHRI PARVATHANENI UPENDRA: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether any progress has been made so far by our research institutes in preparing super conductors from metal alloys rather than from ceramic; and

(b) manner in which the super conductors are likely to revolutionise industrialisation of the country?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY AND THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF OCEAN DEVELOPMENT, ATOMIC ENERGY, ELECTRONICS AND SPACE (SHRI K. R. NARAYANAN): (a) Research institutes in India have observed superconductivity at much lower temperatures in metal alloys as compared to ceramics.

(b) The high temperature superconducting materials and devices are likely to be used in almost all sectors of industry like power generation and transmission energy storage medical and household devices and also in semiconductors.
