Reservation of Posts for SC|ST in Sree Chitra Medical Centre, Trivandrum 2030. SHRI T. K. Q, VADUTHALA: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state. -

(a) what is the percentage of different categories of posts reserved for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes persons in Sree Chitra Medical Centre, Trivandrum;

(b) what is the number of SC|ST, in each category, as on 31st March, 1987 and the total number of men in position in each category;

(Cj) whether it is a fact that the majority of staff engaged in the last grade, such as sweepers, cleaners and attendants belong to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes;

; d) whether it has been brought to the notice of Government that such persons are; not allowed the revised scales of pay as recommended by the Fourth Central Pay Commission with reference to their pre-revised scale and that they are given only the revised scale sanctioned to the lowest grade, which they were not holding at the time of pay-revision; and

(e) if so, what are the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY AND THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF OCEAN DEVELOPMENT, ATOMIC ENERGY, ELECTRONICS AND SPACE (SHRI K. R. NARAYANAN): (a) The present quota of reservations is ten per cent for Scheduled Castes and one per cent for Scheduled Tribes as prescribed by

the Department of Personnel and Training.

(a) whether there are any data of under-employment in the country as at the beginning of 1980-81 and at the end of 1984-85;

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING (SHRI SUKHAM): (a) to (c) The National Sample Survey Organisation (NSSO) collects information about employment-unemployment once in 5 years. The latest (38th Round) relates to the calendar year 1983, the earlier one relates to 1977-78 (32nd Round). In the 32nd Round, a general question regarding "availability for additional work" was put to persons categorized "Working" (or employed) according to usual status.
