(b) whether Government are aware that some of the offices have riot so far allotted those quarters to their employees;

(c) whether it is a fact that such quarters should be allotted within a specified time, if not, what are the reasons therefor;

(d) the loss Government suffered by paying House Rent Allowance to the employees and by non-recovery of rent of those quarters by keeping them vacant; and

(e) the manner in which Government propose to compensate such losses?
