

**Setting up of Central Schools**

525. SHRI SANTOSH BAGRODIA:  
Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) what is the number of Central Schools established in the country as on date, State-wise;

(b) what is the number of Central Schools proposed to be set up during the Seventh Five Year Plan period in different States, specially during 1987-88; and

(c) what is the number of Central Schools proposed to be set up in Rajasthan in 1988-89?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND CULTURE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI KRISHNA SAHI): (a) As on date 632 Kendriya Vidyalayas have been established in the country. State-wise statement is enclosed. (See below).

(b) and (c) It has not been decided yet as to exactly how many Kendriya Vidyalayas will be opened during the VII plan period. It is, therefore not possible to say at this stage as to how many Kendriya Vidyalayas will be set-up in each state in 1987-88 and in Rajasthan in 1988-89.
