Demolition of. Hutments for NB. C. C. Workers

Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the hutments for the construction workers of National Building Construction Corporation near Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium recently demolished by Government;

(b) if so, what are the reasons therefor; and

(c) whether there is any direction from court to protect these hutment dwellers

against demolition and the same is being ignored by the authorities?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI DALBIR SINGH): (a) -No. However some unauthorised hutments' not belonging to the construction workers of NBCC on the plot on which the building of the Department of Electronics is under construction were demolished/removed.

(b) The hutments had to be 'demolished' removed because these were unauthorised.

(c) At the time of demolition/removal of the unauthorised hutments on, 28-3-87 no court order restraining the demolition/removal is reported to be available with the Department of Electronics. A communication from the Dv. Registrar, High Court of Delhi, Delhi was however, received by them on 31-3-1987 after the demolition/removal of these unauthorised hutments.

Per Capita Availability of Milk

781. SHRI V NARAYANASAMY: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:-

(a) Whether it is a fact that the Indian Dairy Corporation has not improved its performance in spite of the introduction of the Operation Flood-II and Operation Flood-III, - -

(b) Whether it is a fact that as per 1984-85 target per capita requirement was (220 grams per day) and the Corporation has achieved only 144 grains per day; and

(c) if so, what are the steps taken by Government to increase the milk production?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND COOPERATION IN, THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA): (a) Indian Dairy Corporation continues to perform the role for which it was set up. Operation Flood Project, implemented with financial assistance from Indian Dairy Corporation has made rapid progress in the recent years in

terms of the number of Dairy. Cooperative Societies organised, their membership, milk procurement, milk marketing and processing, capacities.

(b) The estimated milk production in the country during the year 1984-85. was 41.0 million tonnes (provisional). Based on this and the mid-year population in 1984-85, the per capita availability of milk for that year was estimated at 152 grams per day.

(c) Following measures, have been taken for increasing milk production in the country and for promoting cattle/buffalo development on scientific lines with a view to improve their health and productivity:

(i) Genetic improvement of important cattle breeds by selective breeding in their flocks and up-grading in other selected areas;

(ii) Cross-breeding of non-descript low producing cattle with exotic dairy-breeds;

Progressive genetic improvement of important buffalo breeds by selective breeding and upgrading of non-descript buffaloes for improvement in milk yields;

(iv) Development of feed and fodder resources in order to provide adequate nutrition to livestock.

(v) Organisation of effective animal health services to support the production programme;

(vi) Operation Flood Project also envisages enlarging the infrastructure for providing inputs for increased milk production and marketing through milk producers' Cooperative Societies

Integrated Tribal Development Programme

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF WELFARE (SHRI GIRI-DHAR GOMANGO): (a) No, Sir. Uttar Pradesh has one Integrated Tribal Development Project (ITDP) and Madhya Pradesh has 42 ITDPs.

Schemes for Tribals Below Poverty-line

(a) what are the details of the tribals living below the poverty-line in various States;

(b) what steps Government propose to take for bringing up these tribals above the poverty-line; and

(c) what scheme have been formulated by the Central Government for the welfare of these tribes and what assistance have been extended to these tribes during

the last 2 years THE DEPUTY MINISTER EST THE MINISTRY OF WELFARE (SHRI GIRI-DHAR GOMANGO): (a) The working Group on the Development of Scheduled Tribes during Seventh Five Year Plan estimated that about 85 lakh Scheduled Tribe families were to be economically assisted. For cross the poverty line.

(b) and (c) Family beneficiary oriented programmes are taken up to economically assist the ST families below the poverty-line under IRDP/TTDP covering various sectors of development such as, agriculture, horticulture, minor irrigation, animal husbandry, fisheries, sericulture, forestry, village and cottage industries. The Central Government provide Special Control Assistance to the States/UTs for Tribal sub-plan Programmes. Such Central Assistance released during 1985-W and
