Lack of basic civic amplifies for Sonia Vihar Delhi

H43. SHRIMATI **SURYAKANTA** JAYAWANTRAO PATIL: WU1 Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that a esidential colony with 3000 families in Delhi near Wazirabad Bridge named 'Sonia Vihar' has not been provided with even basic civic amenities like etecrtricity, transport roads, drainage 'and water unlike other unautho rised colonies in Delhi;
 - (b) if so, what are the" reasons therefor;
- (c) whether it is also a fact that the residents of this colony had brought their problems to the notice of the concerned authorities but it was of no 'avail: and
- (d) if so, what is the facual position in the matter?

THE MINISTER OF URBAN DEVE-LOPMENT (SHRIMATI MOHSINA KIDWAI); (a) to (d) Sonia Vihar is unauthorised colony which does not qualify for regularis'atidn ifi accordance with the Government's policy for regularisation of unauthorised colonies covering residential and commercial structures constructed upto 30-6-77 and 16*2-77 respectively. The M. CD. has been undertaking'development of such not colonies nor is the Delhi Water Supply and Sewage Disposal Undertaking providing water sup^ ply and sewerage facilities in such colonies. D. E. S. U. has however, been undertaking electrification of unauthorised colonies which were existing On 1-r-81. In response ' to a representation dated 24-87, from of. Sonia Vihar, D. Residents' Association E. S. U. has asked, for copies of lay-out plan etc, to verify" the eligibility of the colony for electrification. The Residents Association has not furnished the same to the D. E. S. U. so far. The approach road to the colony situated

about two kms. from Wazirabad BridgS main Road is very narrow and the buses cannot be operated on it. However, the residents of the colony have been availing of D. T. C. services from the main Wazirabad Road.

Power Shortage in steel Plajots

*144. SHRI MOSTAFA BIN QUASEM: DR. R. K. PODDAR:

Will the Minister of STEEL. AND MINES, be pleased to state:

- (a) what were the reasons for the recent power shortage in the Steel Plants of the Steel Authority of India Limited;.
- (b) what are the details steps taken to minimis[^] such shortages; and
- (c) what are the results achieved through such steps?

THE MINISTER OF ENERGY AND THE MINISTER OF STEEL AND . MINES, (SHRI VASANT SATHE): (a) Supply of power from public utilities to the SAIL steel plants in the recent, period of January to March, 1987 was by and large satisfactory.

(b) and (c) Supply of power to the steel plants is under constant review at Jnteir-ministerial -feUel. Remedial steps by way of arranging help from other grids to DVC and Orissa State Electricity Board s to the extent possible have been taken.

In order to reduce the dependence of steel plants on public utility supplies, captive power plants of 2 x 60 MW at Durga-pur Steel plant, 3 x 60 MW at Bokaro Steei Plant and 2 x 60 MW at Rourkela Steel Plan are under construction.
