### Guidelines for fixation of Remunerative Prices for Farmers

\*141. SHRI PRAMOD MAHAJAN: /ill the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state;

- (a) what are the guidelines followed the Agriculture Costs and Prices Commission while deciding the remunerative prices to farmers:
- (b) whether it is a fact that there is widespread dissatisfaction amongst the farmers about these guidelines; and.
- (c) if so, what steps Government propose to take in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND COOPERATION IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI YOG-ENDRA MAKWANA): (a) to (c) A Statement is laid on the Table of the Sabha.

#### Statement

- (a) The Commission for Agricultural Costs and Prices is only a recommendatory body. While formulating its recommendations, the Commission is guided by is terms of reference and accordingly, keeps in view the following:
  - (i) the need t<sub>0</sub> provide incentive to the producer for adopting improved technoloby and for developing a production pattern broadly in the light of national requirements;
    - (ii) the need to ensure rational utilin of land, water and other producresources;

- (iii) the likely effect of the price policy on the rest of the economy, particularly on the cost of living, level of wages, industrial cost structure, etc.;
- (iv) the changes in terms of trade between agricultural sector and nonagricultural sector.

The Commission also takes into account not only a comprehensive over-view of the entire structure of the economy of a particular commodity but also a number of important factors; e.g.,

- 1. Cost of production.
- 2. Changes in input prices.
- 3. Input-Output price parity.
- 4. Trends in market prices.
- 5. Demand and supply.
- 6. Inter-crop price partiy.
- 7. Effect on industrial cost structure.
- 8. Effect on general price level.
- 9. Effect on cost of living.
- 10. International market price situa-
- 11. Parity between prices paid and prices received.
