## **Sports hostel for Southern States**

- 1151. SHRI V. RAMANATHAN: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleas, ed to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that the National Institute of Sports (NIS) has opened a sports hostel in Guj-arat recently;
- (b) whether it is also a fact that Tamil Nadu, which has produced a number of top class sportsmen has yet to get a sports hostel, especially with the increasing sports activities going on in the South; and
- (c) the steps taken to set up sports hostel in Tamil Nadu and other Southern States?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT AND THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI P. V. NARASIMHA RAO): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) and (c) The State Government of Tamil Nadu has been requested  $t_0$  provide the necessary building for setting up a sports hostel in that State by the Netaji Subhas National Institute of Sports which establishes such hostels. The State Government has not yet been able to provide a suitable building for the pur. pose. Similarly the State Governments of Kerala and Andhra Pradesh have yet to provide suitable buildings for setting up of sports hostels in those States, although the matter has been taken up with them. There is already a sports hostel functioning in Karnataka at Bangalore.

(b) The services to and from Gurgaon involve a reciprocal arranp^ ment with Haryana, where road and passenger tax is to be paid, whereas U.P. Government has exempted D.T.C, from payment of road and passenger tax for city pattern services to and from NOIDA. However, D.T.C, is already operating inter-State services from Central Secretariat to Gurgaon/Sohna which pass through Dhaula Kuan.
