

lug stations, manning of reserved coaches by Conductors [TTEs and Coach Attendants who have instructions to ensure that the doors of the coaches are kept locked when the train is on the move and open the same only for the passengers having reservation in these coaches. They are also required to ensure that the end doors of vestibuled trains are kept locked between 22.00 hours and 08.00 hours. Short distance passengers are debarred from travelling in reserved coaches and in case they are detected travelling in such coaches, they are fined under the relevant provisions of the Indian Railways Act.

#### Ucome of the Railway 1

2424. SHRI CHITTA BASU: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state the amount paid to the States, in lieu of passenger tax and contribution to railway safety work during 1975-76 to 1985-86 year-wise, as against the total income of the railways during each of these years?

#### Bridge ever Brahmaputra river

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MADHAVRAO SCINDIA): (a) First part of Techno-economic Feasibility Study for rail-cum-road bridge has been completed.

(b) The Ministry of Surface Transport and North Eastern Council have expressed their inability to finance the project due to financial constraints. Due to unremunerativeness of the project, it will not be possible for Railways to take up construction of Rail-cum-Road Bridge.

(f) whether it is also a fact that most of these combination of drugs are irrational and injurious to the health of people; and

(g) -what are the names of analgesic combinations being marketed in the country and what is rational in each case?
