 - (iv) Grant of higher pay scales generally one level above -what has been recommended by the Fourth Central Pay Commission.
- (c) The recommendations the Empowered Committee are under exa mination.

Funds for games and sports in Rajasthan schools

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS AND WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHR1-MATI MARGARET ALVA): 'Sports' being a State subject, it is primarily the responsibility of the State Governments to promote sports and games in their respective areas. The role of the Central Government is limited to supplementing the efforts of tne State Governments in his direction by extending financial assistance under the various schemes operated by the Government of India. No specific amount is allocated to any Statr. nder

any of the schemes. Assistance as admissible is extended on receipt ot proposals from different State Governments including the Rajasthan Government. The amount of assistance to be provided to the Government of Rajasthan during the year 1987-88 and during the Seventh Five Yea* Plan can only be determined after specific requests from that Stat* Government under various schemes of Department have been received, scrutinised and found admissible for financial assistance

Leprosy patients in the country

- (a) what is thw approximate number of leprosy patients in the country and the number of new cases detected every year, state-wise;
- (b) what are the highly endemi* zones in which this disease is mora prevalent;
- (c) what strategies are adopted by the national leprosy eradication programme to bring all the endemic districts under intensive multi-drug treatment;
- (d) what steps are being taken to augement the net-work on facilities for treatment and rehabilitation of the leprosy patients: and
- (e) what arrangements have been made or are being made to provide preventive treatment in areas not so endemic?
