- (a) There is no proposal at present either to reduce or to fully withdraw the duty on newsprint..

- (c) Small and medium newspapers with entitlement of less than 300 metric tonnes are free to obtain their requirements from either the imported-' or. the indigenous va rieties. Small newspapers are fully exemp ted from paying customs duty on imported newsprint. Medium newspapers pay only 50 per cent of the customs duty le viarble on imported newsprint.

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS AND THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINAN. CE (SHRI BHAHM DUTT). (a) and (b), The purchasing power of rupee measured as the reciprocal of the AlLIndia Consumer price Index for Industrial Workers (base 1960—100) increased from 14. 45p paise is Nowmber, 1986 to 14. 53 paise in December, 1986 and remained steady in January, 1987 (latest available).

- (c) The thrust of Government's antiinflationary policy continues to be on effective demand and supply management including strengthening of public distribution system, mopping uP of excess liquidity in the system and action against economic offenders.
- (d) No, sir. The external value of the rupee is linked to a basket of currencies and in line with the changes in the exchange rate of the currencies; n the basket necessary adjustments are made by RBI from time to time.
