

Payment of cess by Automobile manufacturers

2652. SHRI SURENDRA SINGH THAKUR; Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state;

(a) whether all the Automobiles manufacturers are following the Cess Rules, 1984;

(b) whether any mechanism has been devised to ensure that all the manufacturers pay the Cess regularly;

(c) whether some Companies are defaulting in this regard; and

(d) if so, the details of the action taken by the Government?

THE MINISTER OF STATE -IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI JANARDHAN POOJARI); (a) to (c) All manufacturers required to Pay cess in terms of the Automobile Cess Rules 1984, are paying cess regularly alongwith central excise duty before clearance of automobiles from the factory of production.

(d) Does not arise.

(b) The Ministry of Programme Implementation was created in September, 1985. There was no. separate grant for the Ministry during 1985-86 and expenditure continued to be met from the grants of Cabinet Secretariat and Planning Commission. However, separate budget provision have been made in Grant No. 71, Ministry of Programme Implementation for the year 1986-87. Details of expenditure during 1985-86 and provisions in R. E. 1986-87 (Sub-head wise) are as under; —

(c) This Ministry is watching implementation of 20-Point Programme, performance of the infrastructure in the nine Core sectors and all Central sector projects costing more than Rs. 20 crores.

These three items of work were being lu. Jdkd by the Planning Commi. sion/ Cabinet Secretariat earlier and the personnel of these two organisations were transferred alongwith the work to this Ministry: Thus additional expenditure incurred by the new Ministry is minimal. Also, viewed in the Context of the cost of these important programmes and projects being monitored, the expenditure is only a very small fraction of the total cost and is fully justified.

By the very process of monitoring the implementation of projects, shortfalls in production against the targets in the nine infrastructure sectors, and importance of the various poverty allevation programme in the length and breadth of the country, on a regular and continuing basis, the Ministry of Programme Implementation provides necessary warning signals to the implementing and supervising agencies' to undertake such mid-course corrections as are necessary to achieve pre-de-termined targets for various projects, programmes and production in the economy.

Hill areas in Madhya Pradesh

A Sub-Committee of the National Development Council on Hill Areas which 'had finalised the list of hill areas for inclusion in the Hill Area Development Programme in 1965 did not identify any area of Madhya Pradesh for inclusion. The report of the expert group on delineation of new hill areas is being processed.
