(c) what will be the break up of imports in each of the above periods in respect of telephone exchanges, long distance media, satellite systems, under-

ground cables, testing instruments and other equipment, separately;

(d) what are the targets for imports in each of the 3 years in respect of new services like radio paging, cellular mobile radio, facsimile, and videotext, separately;

(e) what is the extent to which the Indian manufacturers will be able to meet the demand in respect of equipment mentioned in the parts (c) and (d) by 1989-90; and

(f) whether the Indian manufacturers will be given opportunity for supplies before resorting to imports and if not, what are the reasons thereof?
