- fa) the total number of persons employed by Rural Electrification Corporation on dailywages for the last three years;
- (b) how many of them have been removed from services during the period and details thereof indicating the period of service rendered by each;
- (c) whether these persons were employed for any additional work entrusted to the Rural Electrification Corporation; if so, the details of the additional work; and if not, the justification for such appointments and removals; and
- (d) what steps Rural Electrification Corporation proposes to take to re-employ the persons who have been removed from service after serving the Corporation for more than six months on daily wages?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF POWER IN THE MINISTRY OF ENERGY (SHRIMATI SUSHILA ROHATGI): (a) to (d) For attending to some additional work of temporary nature necessitating additional hands in different categories such as clerical, typists, waterman, etc. the Rural Electrification had engaged 173 persons on daily wages during the last three years. Out of these 15 persons left on their own, and 35 persons on the expiry of the period of their employment could not be continued further. The details indicating the period of service rendered by each of these persons are given in the enclosed statement.
