(c) how do Government intend to recover this huge amount due for a long time and what action Government have taken so that no more licences and loans are granted to this group; and

(d) whether Industrial Finance Corporation of India has sanctioned any fresh loan to this group during the current year; if so, what are the details in this regard?

(a) whether Government are aware of the recent statement made by the Pakistan Prime Minister in Pak-occupied Kashmir faking the Kashmir issue and supporting the struggle for freedom from the Indian yoke as reported in the *Tribune* of the 24th August, 1986;

(b) if so, how do Government view the utterances of the Prime Minister of Pakistan in the context of Tashkent and Simla Agreements and whether Government feel a definite shift in Pakistan's policy towards India; and

(c) what steps Government contemplate in the matter?
