- (a) what are the details of the amount spent so far on the atomic power plant being set up at Kaiga in Karnataka; and
- (b) what is the probable date for completion of the project and whether the plant is expected to run to full capacity after completion; if not, what are the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF OCEAN DEVELOPMENT, ATOMIC ENERGY, ELECTRONICS AND SPACE (SHRIK, R, NARAYANAN): (a) A total of Rs. 36.40 crores have been spent upto October 1986 towards advance procurement of long time-cycle components, site investigation works and development of infrastructure facilities at Kaiga,

(b) The two units of 235 MW each at Kaiga Atomic Power Project are sheduled to be completed by 1994-95. Both the units are expected to run at their rated capacity,

CHIDAMBARAM); (a) and (b) Two persons have been apprehended in case of murder of General A. S. Vaidya. One of them has been identified as of the Killers of Shri Lalit Maken and Shri Arjun Das. Four travel have been arrested. Efforts are continuing to arrest the other accused person in these cases
