Incentives to Sportsmen

203. SHRI AJIT P. K. JOGI: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state whether in view of the dismal performance of the Indian squad at the recently concluded ASIAD at Seoul, Government propose to provide incentives to encourage sports in rural areas in view of the declining trends in all spheres of games and sports, if so, what are the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS AND WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT IN THE MIN-ISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DE-VELOPMENT (SHRIMATI MARGA-RET ALVA): The experience gained in the recently held X Asian Games at Seoul underlines the need, inter alia of promoting sports in the rural areas. With this aim in view, the scheme of All India Rural Sports Tournaments will be widened at the grass roots, State and National levels so that sports talent available in the rural sector is tapped in an increasing measure for training at the national level. Attractive prizes are given to the winners of these tournaments at national levels and it is hoped that in course of time, the incentives offered will encourage competitive sports in rural areas. Besides the promotion of rural sports through rural sports centres, Nehru Yuva Kendras are expected to further help in the process.
