#### **Navodaya Vidyalayas in Madhya Pradesh**

238. SHRI SURESH PACHOURI: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) what is the programme of Government for opening Navodaya Vidyalayas in the country;

(b) the number of Navodaya Vidyalayas that are proposed to be opened in Madhya Pradesh during the current academic year;

(c) the amount earmarked for Navodaya Vidyalayas for the current academic year; and

(d) the criteria to be adopted for opening these Vidyalayas?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF EDUCATION AND CULTURE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI KRISHNA SAHI): (a) The programme of the Government of India is to establish one Navodaya Vidyalaya in each District of the country during the Seventh Five Year Plan.

(b) Seven.

(c) Rupees twenty five crores.

(d) Navodaya Vidyalayas are sanctioned on the basis of suitability of offers made by the State Government of land and temporary/permanent buildings for the proposed Vidyalayas. Offers made by various individuals/organisations are also examined in consultation with the State Government.
